

ADMISSION WITH ADVANCED STANDING
Transfer Students

To apply to the University of Nebraska College of Law for admission with advanced standing, send all of the following to:

1. Complete the College of Law application and submit the \$25 application fee. In response to question 12, please indicate that you are applying as a transfer student;
2. Submit a copy of your LSAT/LSDAS report. You must request that an official copy be sent from the Law School Admission Services.
3. Submit transcripts from all undergraduate and graduate college and/or university work. These transcripts may come from the college of university directly or with the LSAT/LSDAS report from Law School Admission Services.
4. Submit transcripts of all law school work showing grades received after one full year or more of law study. To expedite your application, a letter from the Dean of your current law school listing your grades for your last semester will substitute temporarily for a transcript showing these grades. An explanation of the grading system used at your current law school should accompany your transcript.
5. Request that the Dean of your current law school provide a letter
 1. stating that you are in good standing at the end of at least one full year of study and eligible to continue at the law school should you so desire, and
 2. indicating your class rank.
6. Submit the current catalog of your present law school or a copy of the descriptions of the courses, together with credit hours, which you seek to have considered for transfer credit.

A transfer student must complete at least 45 graded hours of coursework at the University of Nebraska College of Law to be considered for graduation honors.
