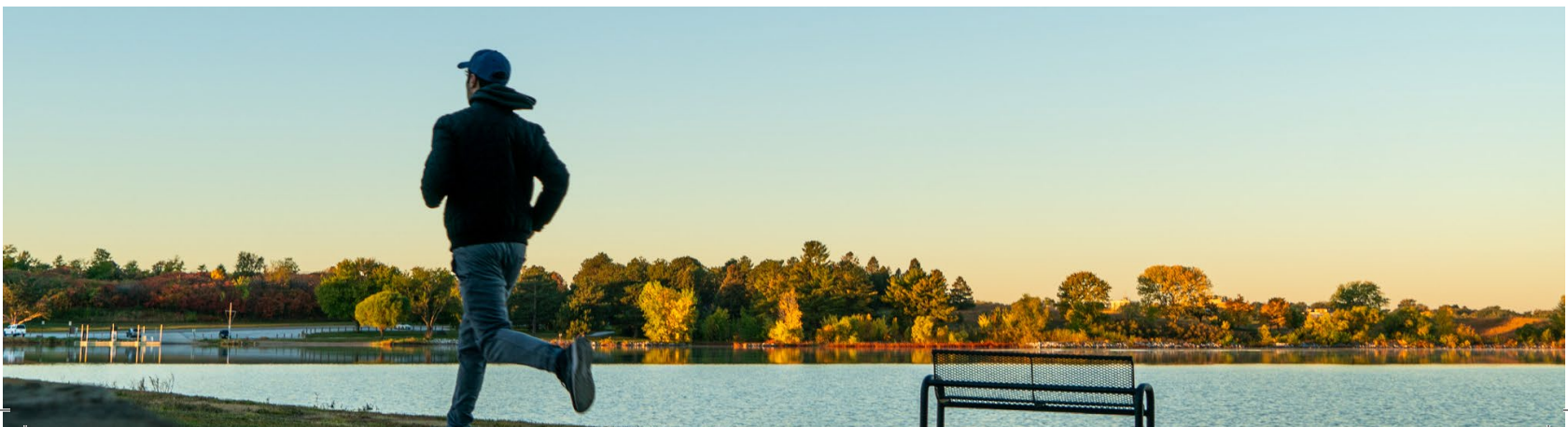
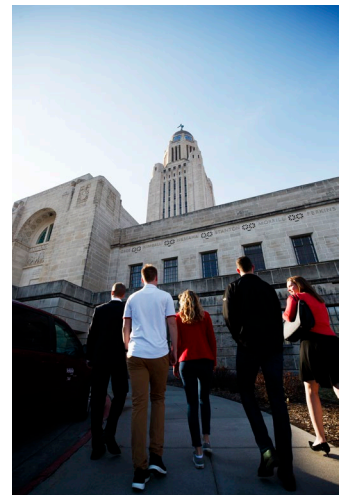




NEBRASKA LAW

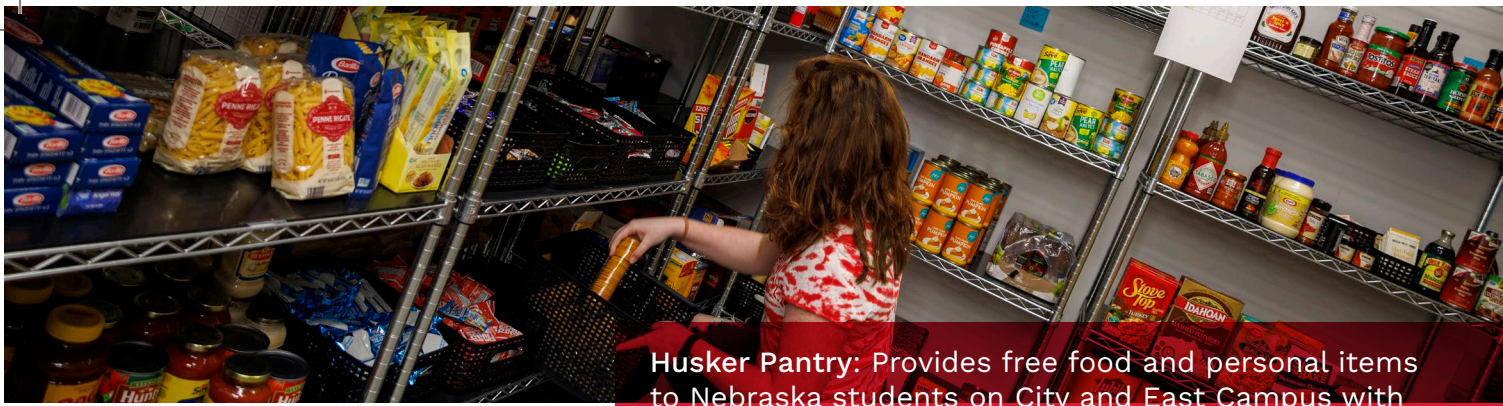

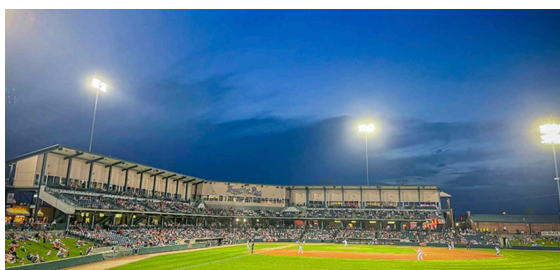

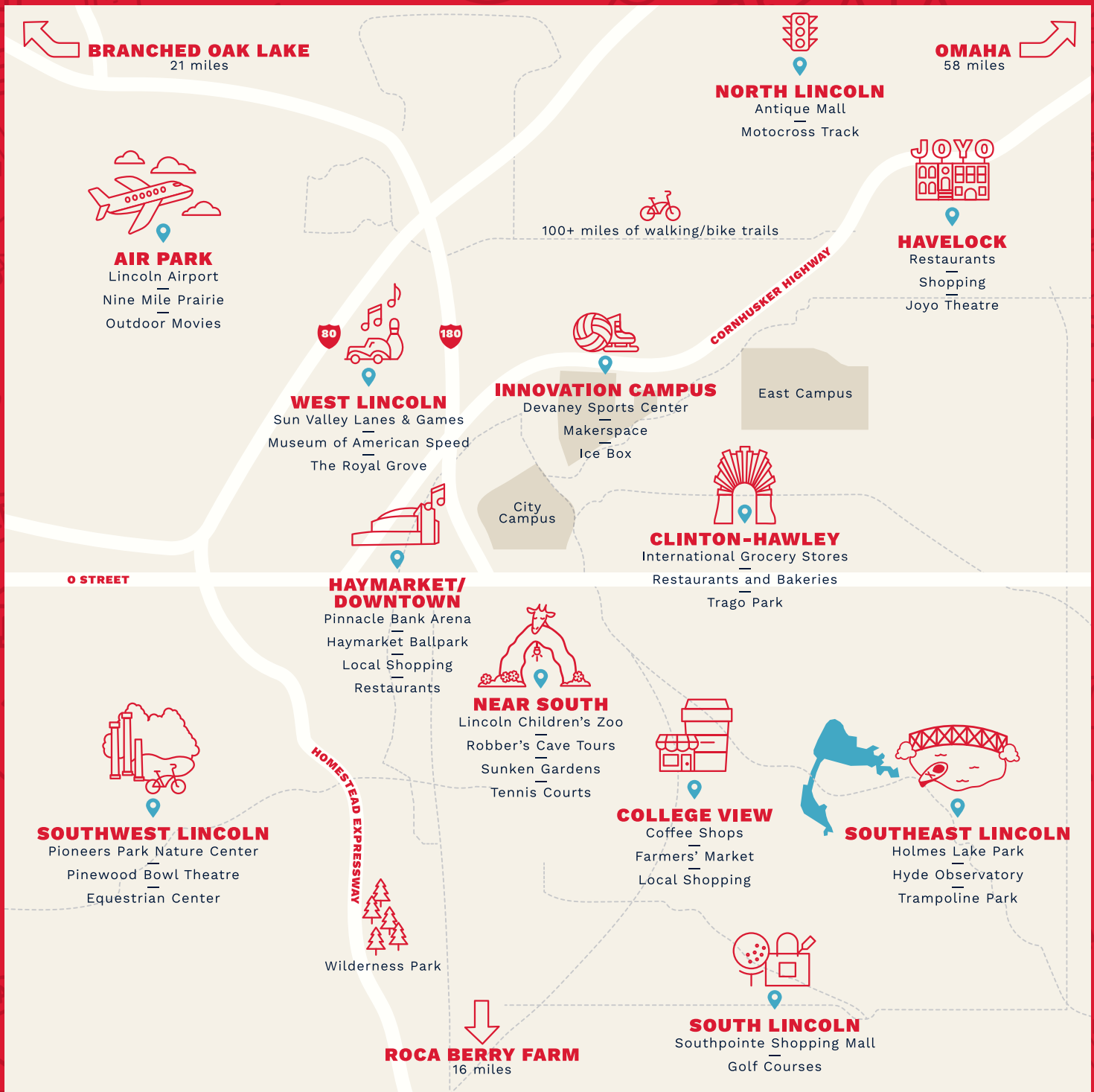
